

Provincial Changes to Learning Method for K-12 Students



On Tuesday, November 24, the Government of Alberta announced enhanced public health measures that impact K-12 students. These restrictions are mandatory for all students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 across the province.

Students in Grades 7-12

- All students in Grades 7-12 will move to at-home learning beginning **Monday, November 30, 2020** until **Friday, January 8, 2021** (except for during winter break from December 21 to January 1).
- These students will resume in-person classes on **Monday, January 11, 2021**.
- Diploma exams are **optional** for the rest of the school year. Families may choose to write an exam or receive an exemption for January, April, June, and August 2021 exams.

Students in Grades K-6

- All students in Grades K-6 will continue in-person classes until their scheduled winter break begins on Monday, December 21.
- After winter break, students will move to at-home learning for **one week** from **Monday, January 4** until **Friday, January 8, 2021**.
- Students will resume in-person classes on **Monday, January 11, 2021**.
